### ***Expenses:***

- ERMEP funds learner accommodations and travel: once to the community and once home (University) at the end of the rotation.
- Transportation within the community is the learner's responsibility.
- *It is recommended that all learners have a vehicle...*no public transportation, other than taxis, are available in ERMEP communities.
- ERMEP is not responsible for organizing the learners' transportation to and from the community or within the community.

### ***Accommodations:***

- B&B's, Billets, Shared Houses/Apartments, Hospital Dorms.
- Meals are the learner's responsibility; do not expect your accommodations to feed you.
- Most accommodations will provide cupboard and fridge space and kitchen access.
- ERMEP accommodations are for the *learners use only*. Accommodations are not provided for other family members or friends.
- No pets allowed at any of the accommodations.

### ***Information Packages:***

- All learners will receive an information package. It will contain preceptor, accommodation, and community information. As well as an evaluation and expense form for you to fill out at the end of your rotation. Some packages will contain hospital forms that will need to be filled out and sent off immediately.
- It is the learner's responsibility to contact their assigned preceptor and accommodation to receive further information regarding their rotation/stay. ***This should be done as soon as the learner receives their information package.***
